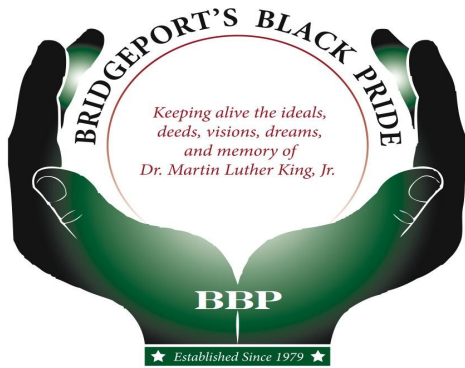

Bridgeport's Black Pride-

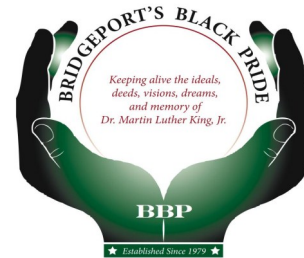
